










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


Trees:

-  Legacy tree: Specimen tree to provide long term large canopy cover.
-  Avenue tree planting : Urban street trees to primary and secondary circulation structure.
-  Structure tree planting: Providing unified structure within parks and squares.
-  Residential street trees: Fruiting and flowering small to medium scale.
-  Garden tree: Small to medium scale trees or large shrubs with seasonal interest.
-  Woodland edge tree: Native species hedgerow or woodland edge tree.












Hedgerow:

-  H1 Native species hedgerow mix.
-  H2 Native species clipped hedgerow.
-  H3 Native species evergreen clipped hedgerow.




Swales:

-  SW1 Bioswale planted strip within hard paving.
-  SW2 Bioswale mix with part hard edge/part planted bank.
-  SW3 Damp meadow mix wet - dry habitat swale.

Amenity plants:

-  PS Evergreen shrub and hedgerow species forming privacy strip to private frontage.
-  EV1 Evergreen ground cover mix with shade tolerant ferns and grasses.
-  WE Native species ground cover mix with ferns, grasses and bulbs.
-  CIV1 Evergreen ground cover mix with ornamental grasses and bulbs.
-  CIV2 Evergreen shrub planting clipped to plinth.
-  ORN1 Ornamental shrub, grasses, herbaceous and bulbs mix. Species selected to provide distinct character to garden spaces.
-  ORN2 Ornamental shrub, grasses, herbaceous and bulb planting including edible herbs.
-  ORN3 Edible planting species including fruiting shrubs.
-  ORN4 Ornamental grasses and specimen shrub / tree planting.
-  ORN5 Companion planting herbaceous species with shrubs, grasses and bulb mix.
-  C Climbing plants trained against building elevations or boundary walls.

Lawns and Meadows:

-  G1 Hard wearing amenity turf mix for sports and recreational use.
-  G2 Flowering lawn mix.
-  G3 Ornamental lawn turf mix.
